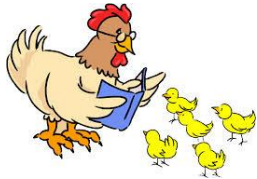


Communication and Language

- Recognise and respond to familiar sounds e.g. a knock on the door.
- Identify action words by pointing to the correct picture.
- Use gestures, sometimes with speech.



Physical Development

- Run safely on whole foot.
- Squat with steadiness and rise to feet without use of hands.
- Turn pages in a book.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Show awareness of boundaries and expectations of the Nursery setting.
- Express own preferences and interests.
- Learn to distract self when upset e.g. by engaging in new play activity.
- Building confidence during preparation of Christmas Play.



Literacy

- Distinguish between marks they make.
- Fill in missing words from a known story or rhyme.
- Have favourite story, song or rhyme.

Mathematics

- Use the language of size.
- Use language of quantities such as 'more' and 'a lot'.
- Recite some numbers in sequence.
- Understand some talk about immediate past and present e.g. 'before' and 'later'.

Understanding the World

- In pretend play, imitate everyday actions from own family or cultural background e.g. making tea.
- Begin to have own friends.
- Operate mechanical toys e.g. pulling back on a friction car.
- Recognise seasons - Autumn and Winter.
- Know about some celebrations - Diwali, Eid, Bonfire Night and Christmas.



Expressive Arts and Design

- Join in singing familiar songs.
- Begin to make-believe by pretending.
- Create sound by banging, tapping, shaking or blowing.
