

Communication and Language

Physical Development

- Copy some letters e.g. letters from their name using correct formation.
- Use tripod grip, holding pencil near the tip with good control.
- Jump off an object and land appropriately.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Be more outgoing towards unfamiliar people and events.
- Initiate play and conversations independently.
- Enjoy responsibility of carrying out small tasks.

Literacy

- Know that information can be retrieved from books.
- Be aware of the way stories are structured.
- Hear and say initial sounds in words.


- Recognise numerals 1-5.
