- Finding out about the celebration of Easter.



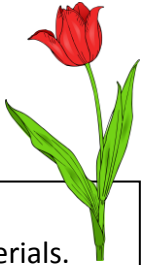
History/Geography

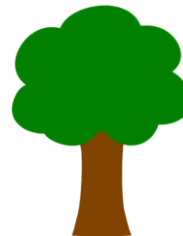
Science
