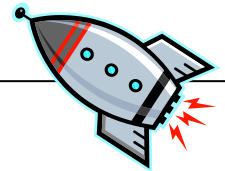

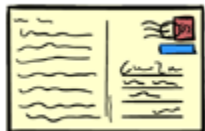
History/Geography
