- Naming continents and their physical features.

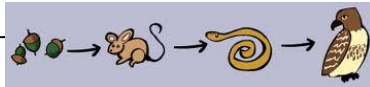


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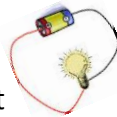
- Developing good relationships with each other.
