

School Uniform Policy

The Governing Body expects Broadfield pupils to wear the school uniform as listed below. Details of our uniform are published annually in the school prospectus. Children will be gently reminded if they are wearing clothing or shoes which are not uniform or are unsuitable. The class teacher or a member of the SLT will speak to parents where there is an ongoing problem and the principal has a template letter for parents in the case of persistent non-compliance. Although uniform is not compulsory in Nursery, most of our younger children do wear it.

Our uniform comprises:

Girls Plain Grey/black skirt, shorts, trousers or pinafore dress.
Plain white polo shirt (with school logo optional) or blouse.
Plain red sweatshirt or cardigan, with school crest.
Plain grey/black or white socks or plain grey/black woollen tights.
Red & white gingham dress (summer)
Sensible flat soled black shoes

Boys Plain Grey/black trousers or shorts
Plain white polo shirt (with school logo optional)
Plain red sweatshirt, with school crest
Plain grey, black or white socks
Sensible flat soled black shoes

Plain Black shorts
Plain White round necked T-shirt
Plain Black/Navy Track suit or sweatshirt (no hood) and jogging bottoms (for outside use)
Trainers for use on the field or playground

Notes

Indoor PE is done in bare feet

For PE sweatshirts without a hood are preferred for health and safety reasons.

No jewellery should be worn to school other than ear studs or jewellery worn for religious reasons. No jewellery may be worn during swimming lessons and other PE and games lessons.

A plastic cap is required for swimming lessons, and surgical tape should be used to cover any earrings during PE.

No makeup or nail polish is permitted, and long hair should be tied back.

When playing football, children are advised to wear either trainers with a strong grip or football boots. Shin pads are also recommended.

Although uniform is not compulsory in Nursery, most of our younger children do wear it.
