Design and Do:

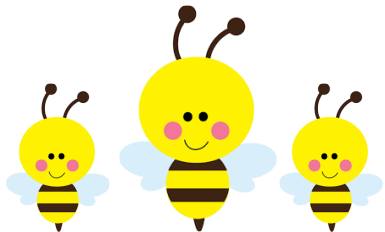
Create a piece of artwork using the style of a famous artist.
