Write from 0-10 on paper plates/paper. Lay them on the floor around your room.

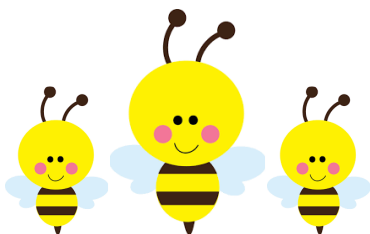
When your adult calls out a number, can you jump on the correct one?
