Make 2 lists of nouns, adjectives and verbs that show the city in a positive and a negative way. This is how we create a mood in our writing.

If you are finding it tricky, then use the English help sheet for some ideas of words to use.

Write a short paragraph imagining that you are walking through the city. Describe what you can see, hear and smell around you.

Think about the mood you are trying to create and which words you will include to achieve this.

Use the help sheet for ideas for words, if you are finding it tricky.

Choose a recipe from a recipe book.

Use ratio and proportion to scale your recipe up or down. Work out how much of each ingredient will you need to feed:

Brave-Bee Challenge


