




Home-Learning Challenge	English	Maths	Topic
 <p>Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Draw your favourite toy and label your picture.</p>	<p>Make a nature collection of three different types of things eg leaves, stones, conkers, sticks. Count carefully how many you have in each group.</p>	<p>Write a list of all the things you can think of that have wheels, and draw a picture of your favourite one.</p>
 <p>Brave-Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Find or draw pictures of 2 toys and write captions of how you play with them.</p>	<p>Practise writing numbers, how high can you go? Use your numbers to practice counting up and back to 10, you could even shout 'blast off!' when you get back to zero!</p>	<p>Write a list of places that you have travelled to on a train with your family, or where you would like to go.</p>
 <p>Super-Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Ask an adult what toys they played with as a child. Write a list of the toys and then write a sentence about which was their favourite toy and why.</p>	<p>Create your own number-line to show numbers to 20 and beyond.</p>	<p>Draw a picture of a person and label the parts of the body we use for our 5 senses.</p>
