




Home-Learning Challenge	English	Maths	Topic
 <p>Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Draw a story map that shows your journey to school.</p> <p>Think about what you do to get ready for school in the morning as well as the landmarks you pass on the way.</p>	<p>5 x table puzzle</p> <p>5 10 15 20 25</p> <p>Karen is given 3 darts. She throws them at the board above. Which 3 numbers would she need to hit to get the following scores? 30, 55, 15, 40, 45</p> <p>She could hit the same number more than once. Are there any with multiple possible answers?</p>	<p><b>Create and Make:</b></p> <p>Create a piece of artwork that shows the celebration of Christmas or Eid-Al-Fatr.</p> <p>Please remember, in Islam it is forbidden to draw Allah or the Prophet Muhammed [PBUH]</p>
 <p>Brave-Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Find and copy a set of instructions from somewhere at home.</p> <p>For example: a cooking recipe or a Lego building kit.</p> <p>You may also wish to photograph examples of instructions you see around town.</p>	<p>On Thursday 42 packets of sweets were sold.</p> <p>On Friday, 34 more were sold, and on Saturday another 146.</p> <p>Use a pictorial or written method to calculate how many sweets were sold altogether.</p> <p>Create some similar word problems of your own.</p>	<p><b>Design and Do:</b></p> <p>Find out about foods that are in season at this time of year – foods that can be grown locally and sustainably without travelling miles from abroad.</p> <p>Find a recipe that uses these foods, make it and photograph the results stating what the ingredients were and why they are sustainable.</p>
 <p>Super-Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Write a haiku poem about a type of weather.</p> <p>Remember a haiku has 5 syllables (beats) in the first and third lines and 7 syllables in the second line.</p> <p>We will be learning about these nearer to Christmas.</p>	<p>When your family go food shopping, select two items from the list and add the cost using the traditional column addition method.</p> <p>Repeat as many times as you can, using two different items each time.</p> <p>Present your work by drawing pictures of the items you choose, alongside your column addition calculation.</p>	<p><b>Research and Report:</b></p> <p>Use the internet or books to research the significance of Remembrance Day.</p> <p>You could ask relatives if there are any personal connections to the armed forces in your family.</p>
