Home-Learning Challenge	English	Maths	Торіс
Bee Challenge	Practice drawing circles and lines. (Remember to always start at the top for vertical lines and for circles go anti-clockwise). You can use paper/pen, white boards/pen, or trays of sand/salt/flour to mark make in.	At dinner time, compare your plate to your family members'- talk about who has more/less food in general and which specific items have the most/least.  e.g. your brother has more peas and you have less.	Build a dark den with blankets, cushions and chairs. Make it so you can't see any light.  Bring torches into it – can you make sad/happy/funny faces by shining torches onto your face? Look at books using the torches.
Brave-Bee Challenge	Can you recognise any letters from your name in your environment?  Take a photo of where you have found them.	Can you measure each member of your family?  Who is the tallest?  Who is the shortest?  Can you draw them (or take a photo) in order from the shortest to the tallest?	Ask an adult to take you outside when it is dark.  What can you see? What can you hear? Do you know what any of the sounds belong to? Can you recognise any animal sounds? Help your grown up to write a list of them all.
Super-Bee Challenge	Can you ask your grown up to write the names of the people in your family?  Have a go at copying them.  Extension: Can you recognise the first sounds in your family members' names?  E.g. d for Danny. Can you find a triangle, circle, rectangle or square shaped object?  Extension: How many of each shape can you find?	Use the Internet or a non fiction book to research some night time animals.  Choose one to draw and then record yourself on Tapestry telling us all about it.
