











Home-Learning Challenge	English	Maths	Topic
 <p>Bee Challenge</p>	<p>What is your favourite planet in the solar system?</p> <p>Draw it and try to label all the sounds you hear in its name!</p>	<p>Can you find things that match in your house and make a pair?</p> <p>How many pairs can you make?</p> <p>Take a picture of all the pairs you found!</p>	<p>Draw yourself as an astronaut. Record yourself talking about what you would do in space and what planets you would travel to!</p> 
 <p>Brave-Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Can you get a big bowl and make your own 'Silly Soup'?</p> <p>(The 'Silly Soup' song can be found on YouTube).</p> <p>Search your house for rhyming pairs to put in your bowl and write a list of the pairs you find</p> <p>e.g. sock and clock, man and van.</p>	<p>Can you see and count six, seven, or eight stars in the sky?</p> <p>Once you have counted, draw the number of stars you saw and label them 1-8.</p> 	<p>Create your own rocket using only shapes!</p> <p>Which shapes did you use?</p> 
 <p>Super-Bee Challenge</p>	<p>Can you write a label for the below pictures?</p> <p>Sound out the words and write the sounds you can hear.</p> <p>Extension: write a caption for one of the pictures e.g. The fast rocket.</p>   	<p>Be a human balancing scale!</p> <p>Find 5 different things in your home and weigh them with your hands.</p> <p>Then, put them in order from heaviest to lightest.</p> 	<p>Create your own alien character! Draw a picture of it and give it a name.</p> <p>Then create your own planet for them to live on using loose parts. Record yourself saying what your planet is like and what fun things your alien does on it!</p>
